Swissmetal supports training centre in Tramelan

Swissmetal actively supports the Zentrum für Technik und Ausbildung der Decolletage- und Verzahnungsindustrie (Centre for Technology and Training of the Décolletage Industry), a department of the Centre Interrégional de Perfectionnement (CIP-CTDT, interregional training centre) in Tramelan. Swissmetal produces and sells worldwide high-quality special products made of copper and copper alloys which are mainly used in the electronics, telecommunications, air travel, petroleum, automobile, stationery and watch/clock industries and in the architectural sector. In financial year 2006, Swissmetal achieved turnover of CHF 357.6 million. As at mid-December 2007, the company had 756 full time-employees.
